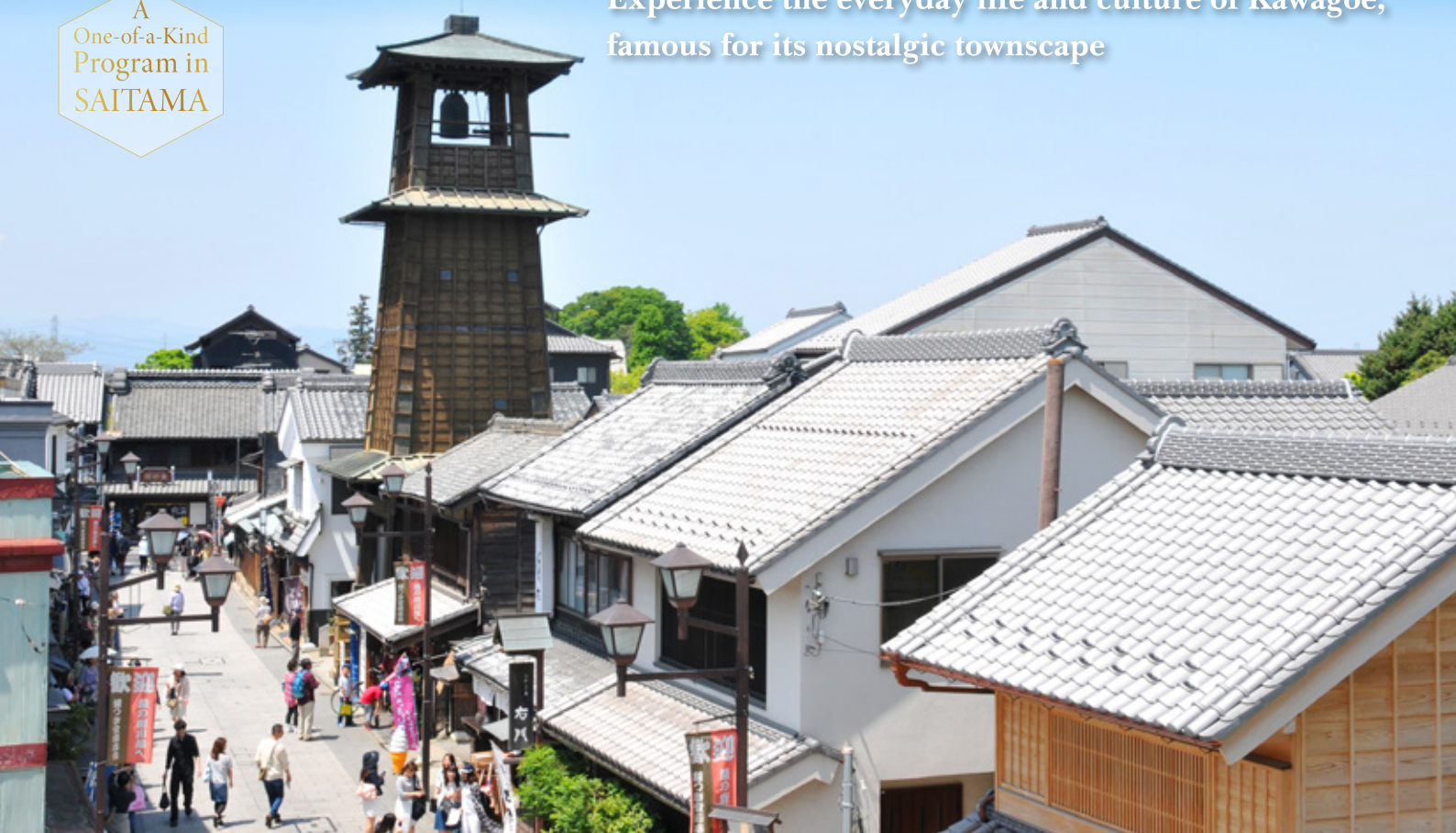

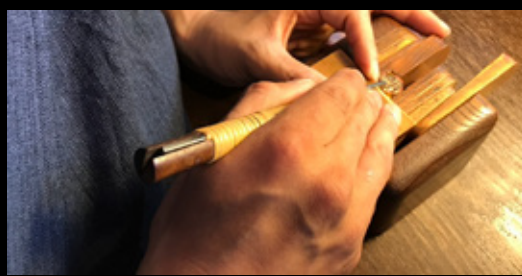


## *“A Taste of Edo in Koedo Kawagoe”*

You'll also get a tea plantation tour of Kawagoe Tea, the root of Sayama Tea, one of the three best teas in Japan.
