

## The SL Paleo Express & Nagatoro River Boating =Chichibu Railway=

Chichibu Railway runs through northwestern Saitama across countryside and mountains, with an enthralling window view you'll never tire of watching. The sightseeing train "Steam Locomotive The Paleo Express" operates every year from spring to autumn. Visitors can also enjoy the traditional activity "Rhine Cruise the Nagatoro River," which has continued for over 100 years since operation began in Nagatoro Town, an area on the Chichibu Railway.







The Paleo Express was established in 1988 as the closest steam locomotive sightseeing train from Tokyo. Rich nature is visible from the train window. The on-board catering trolley offers boxed lunches and light meals made from local ingredients for your travelling enjoyment.

You can get off at Paleo Express stop Nagatoro Station, and then walk aroundthe national natural landmark of "Nagatoro." At the large flat rock formations, Iwadatami Rocks, you can see remnants of the Earth's tectonic plate movement up close.

We recommend experiencing the unpredictability of nature by riding in a Japanese boat on Rhine Cruise the Nagatoro River. You can enjoy both the gentle currents and exciting rapids all in one place. You won't be able to take your eyes off of the boatman who steers with a special boating technique using a single rod.
