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Explore “Tokorozawa Sakura Town” and Its Surroundings

We invite you to enjoy the main facility “Tokorozawa Sakura Town” and adjacent store Tokorozawa City Tourist Information& Local Products “YOT-TOKO,” creations of the joint project between Kadokawa and Tokorozawa City dubbed “COOL JAPAN FOREST Initiative!” After visiting Musashino Reiwa Shrine,

which displays a fusion of ancient and modern Japan, you can watch projection mapping at the Kadokawa Culture Museum Bookshelf Theater. Then enjoy a meal of local delicacy niku udon (beef udon) at YOT-TOKO, and browse the store’s wide selection of teas, sweets and various goods!

The ceiling at Musashino Reiwa Shrine, depicting Kadokawa’s symbol, the “Phoenix,” was painted by the world-renowned artist Yoshitaka Amano, known for his character design for Final Fantasy, illustrations and scenic design for theater and film.

YOT-TOKO parking can accommodate 4 tour buses (reservation required). Tokorozawa is conveniently located on the way from Haneda or Narita Airport to Karuizawa or Nikko, making for a perfect stop in between tour locations.

At JIGONA Cafe in YOT-TOKO you can enjoy a menu of local delicacies such as nikujiru udon (meat broth udon noodles), green tea soft serve ice cream, and even unusual items such as green tea cola.
